PRODUCTS

Agriclad represents a range of roof, wall and liner profiles, manufactured from high quality, galvanised steel.

Profiled sheeting is available in 0.5mm and 0.7mm thicknesses with a choice of polyester or high performance plastisol protective external finishes.

Plastisol coated steel is available in standard lengths from 0.5m to 10m whilst polyester coated material is available in lengths from 0.5m to 8m. If longer lengths are required in the polyester coated steel please contact the sales office. Longer than standard length orders are priced on application.

ROOF

There are five Agriclad roofing profiles available, each offering a subtly different finish.

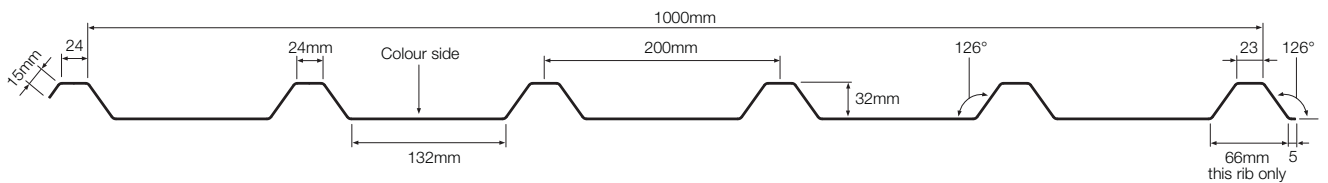
Roof profiles are fixed with the narrow corrugations facing uppermost. This provides a large stiffened trough that is capable of safely dispersing large volumes of rainwater.

Whilst these profiles are designed for the roof, they can also be used as a wall.

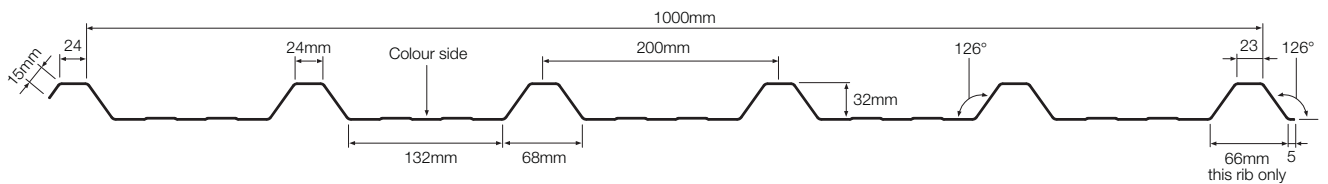

WALL

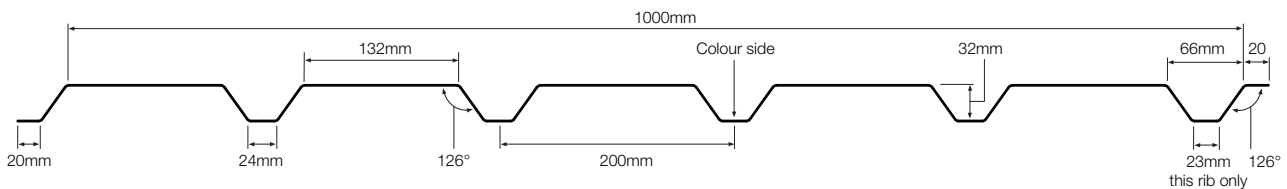
Agriclad wall cladding is available in the same external profiles as the roof products, with one addition.

The fundamental difference to the roof application is in the way the wall is installed; the broad ribs face out providing an attractive, plank-like appearance, with clean lines for a smooth design. Fixings sit in the narrow trough of the profile, helping make them unobtrusive.

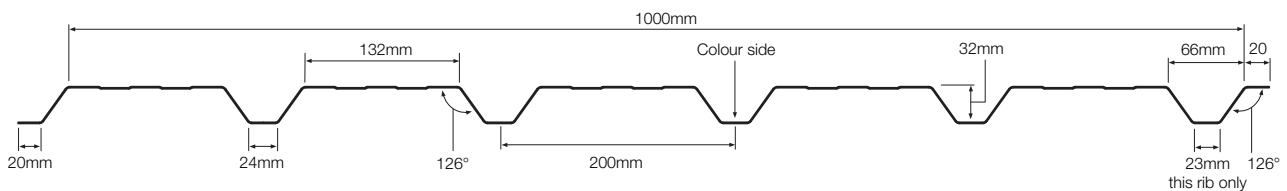

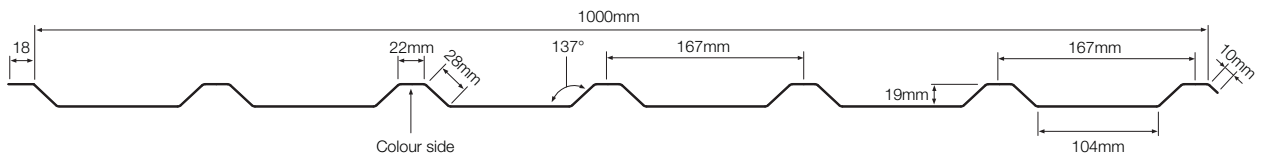
LINER

The Agriclad Liner profiles are a trapezoidal 'box' section offering an attractive internal face with a convenient one metre cover width when installed.

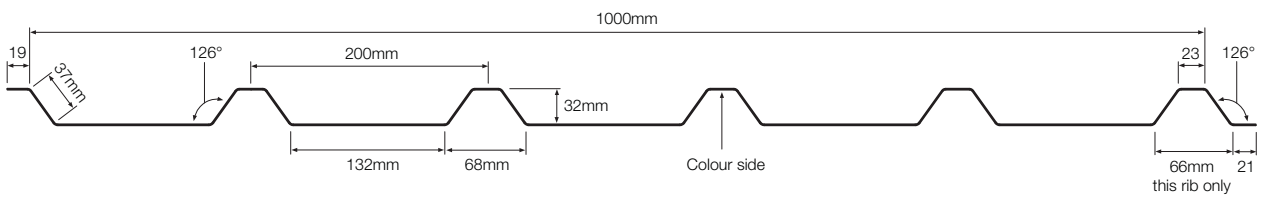
The liner is available in 0.4mm and 0.7mm gauges. This layer forms the inside skin of a building envelope when a twin-skin construction is required.

Liner profiles have a 10 micron thick polyester coating that is light grey in colour.

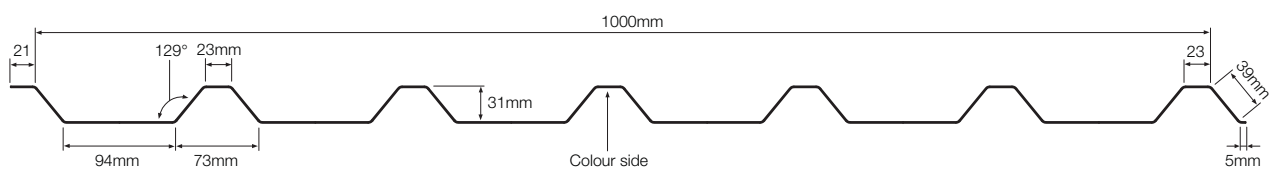

MATERIALS AND COLOURS

Available in our premium polyester or high performance plastisol external finishes.

Agriclad sheets are manufactured using hot dipped zinc coated steel and are available in premium polyester or high performance plastisol external finishes. The reverse face is coated with light grey high performance polyester as standard.

The polyester finish is a premium product that offers good protection and aesthetics at an extremely attractive price. Where additional protection and extended corrosion resistance is required the 200 micron abrasion-resistant leathergrain embossed plastisol finish is the coating of choice. This coating offers all of the performance benefits of some of the more expensive industrial plastisols but at a cost that is always outstanding value.

Both finishes are available in a range of standard colours at short lead times.

ACCESSORIES

All the necessary accessories can be supplied to achieve a successful installation of Agriclad sheets.

Eurobar

Category Cladding is fortunate to stock the Eurobar spacer systems including standard Eurobar, Eurobar Extra and the Eurobar Extra Mast. Eurobar Extra and Eurobar Extra Mast have been designed in and for the 21st century. With increasing demands for better thermal performance, these products can offer extra stability and allow greater depths of insulation, to help achieve low U-value wall and roof constructions.



Fillers, tapes and mastics

All of the basic installation accessories are available, such as profiled foam filler blocks, sealant tapes and mastics. Available individually or as part of the complete cladding package, all elements complement one another and offer good performance at extremely competitive prices.

Fasteners

Typically, sheeting is installed to either cold rolled purlins, hot rolled steelwork or timber.

A self drilling carbon steel fastener with individual drill tip, 5/16" hex head and neoprene bonded sealing washer can be supplied to suit any of these applications. These fasteners are designed to be installed in the trough of the profile.

A self drilling screw specifically designed for 'stitching' is available for closing sheet side laps and securing flashings.

Snap on colour caps can be supplied to offer additional protection to the head of the fastener and to conceal the fixing.

Insulation

Category Cladding works with the biggest names in the insulation industry to offer the most suitable product at the most competitive price.

Customers not only benefit from the convenience of a single source supply of products but also get the insulation they need at a price that is hard to beat.



Flashings

Agriclad flashing trims are designed to neatly close off all perimeter details. Standard section items are available "off the shelf". However, all flashings can be manufactured to exact customer specification.

Manufactured from the same material as the sheet profile, these items offer excellent colour match and functional performance. Typically supplied in 3m lengths for ease of handling, these items can be lapped or butt jointed with straps, subject to section shape.

Where exceptionally large flashings are required further bends may be necessary to ensure adequate rigidity.

Rooflights

Rooflights are available in matching profiles to allow simple integration into the steel cladding sheets.
